



# Allow Remote Desktop to Carry Your Home Printer, Camera, and Microphone to Your Work Computer

By default, Remote Desktop does not carry your home printer, camera, or microphone to your work computer, but you can enable this.


First, run **Remote Desktop**, and put in your computer name if it's not there yet. Then click on **Show Options**, then the **Local Resources** tab.





**1. To include your home printer:** On the **Local Resources** tab, checkmark the box next to **Printers**.



**2. To include your home microphone:** On the **Local Resources** tab, under **Remote Audio**, click **Settings**. Then click the circle to "**Record from this computer**," then click **OK**.



**3. To include your home camera:** on the **Local Resources** tab, click the **More** button. Then click the + button to expand your **Video capture devices**, and check that your home camera shows there. Checkmark your camera, and you can also click the option for "**Devices that I plug in later**" in case you haven't attached your camera yet. Click **OK**.



When you've made these selections, click the **Connect** button and continue as usual. These settings are sticky, so you need to do them only once.
